## **ABSTRACT**

### **Air Medical Transport Weather Limitations Education**

A committee was formed as a result of one of the action items developed at the HEMS Weather Summit held March 21-23, 2006 in Boulder, Colorado. The summit was hosted by NCAR and the FAA. This committee is tasked with developing an education curriculum to inform requesting agencies (Fire departments, rescue squads, dispatch centers, ICUs, law enforcement, Emergency physicians and Emergency Departments - usually the unit secretary or nurse) about weather hazards and limitations to aviation and how weather affects air medical operations. Organizations will help with distribution of the 12 to 16 minute education program by posting on various websites for download and making copies for individual program use.

### **Project Objectives:**

1. Develop a script through a multi-disciplinary approach with committee members representing pre-hospital, hospital and EMS pilot groups.
2. Assist in the production of electronic and written end product.
3. Develop distribution points of contact.
